Judging: The Finnish Star evaluation system will be used in categories Pre-Chicks, Chicks, Springs B, Pre-Young I, Pre-Young II, Pre-Young III and Young. In the Finnish star evaluation system skaters will be judged by giving stars from different technical elements and presentation components. ISU judging system will be used in categories Debs A, Novice B, Novice C, Junior B.

The organizer will invite the judges and pay their expenses.

Preliminary Competition Schedule:

Competition on Saturday 25th of January 2014 **at 8.00 - 20.00**. Organizing club reserves the right to change the schedule. Entry Fee: Star evaluation, 50 € for each skater.
ISU evaluation, 60 € for each skater
Please note that entry fees are refunded only against medical certificate.

- **Draw:** The official draw will be held on Wednesday 22nd of January 2014 at 17.30 at the ice rink. The result will be published on the official web page of the competition on Thursday 23rd of January.
- Practice: Free practice on Friday 24th of January, 2014 at 15.00-17.30
- **Music:** Music will be played on CD player. Music must be provided on CD (no CD-RWs or DVDs). CDs equipped with the full name of the competitor, category and the name of the club must be submitted to the organizer's desk before the relevant event and picked up from the same place after event.
- Awards: Three first standings will be awarded with a cup and a diploma. All other competitors will receive a diploma at the awarding ceremony.
- Admissions: This event will be open to the public.
- **Expenses:** The participants pay travel expenses, board and accommodation themselves.

born 2005-2006 Free program: max 2 min

1. Some single jumps

At least 2 different spins (at least 3 revolutions)

Note: Axel and double jumps are not permitted

<u>Springs</u> B (Silmut B) born in 2002 and younger Free program: Girls 2.30 min. (+/-10 sec.)

1. Max. 5 jump elements

- One of which must be single Axel jump

- At least 1 double jump (it is allowed to try all double jumps)

- Max. 2 jump combinations or jump sequences of which max. 1 jump combination may consist of 3 jumps

- If a double jump is executed as a solo jump, it can only be repeated once as part of a jump combination or jump sequence

2. Max. 3 different spins (every spin has to have different abbreviation!)

- Spin combination (8 revolutions) with or without change of foot

- One Spin with one position and no change of foot or flying spin with no change of foot and position (5 revolutions: any position - upright, layback, camel, sit)

- One spin different nature than previous, 1 position spin 5 revolutions or spin combination 8 revolutions

3. Step sequence must fully utilize the ice surface

4. At least 2 unsupported spiral positions

- **3.** Step sequence (at least $\frac{1}{2}$ cover of the ice)
- 4. At least 2 spirals (in spirals at least 2 positions à 3 sec.)

Note: Axel and double jumps are not allowed

PRE-YOUNG II, Girls	born 2002- 1999, Finnish Star-evaluation
(Taitajat ei Axelia)	Free program: max 2.30 min.

- 1. Max. 5 jump elements.
- At least one (1) and no more than three (3) jump combinations or sequences
- 2. At least one (1) but not more than three (3) spins (min. 3 revolutions)
- 3. Step sequence (at least ½ cover of the ice)
- 4. At least 2 spirals (in spirals at least 2 positions à 3 sec.)

Note: Axel and double jumps are not allowed

PRE-YOUNG III, Girls (Taitajat Axel)

born 1999 or later, Finnish Star-evaluation Free program: max 2.30 min.

1. Max. 5 jump elements.

- At least one (1) and no more than three (3) jump combinations or sequences

2. At least one (1) but not more than three (3) spins (min. 3 revolutions)

3. Step sequence (at least ½ cover of the ice)

4. At least 2 spirals (in spirals at least 2 positions à 3 sec.)

Note: Double jumps are not allowed

<u>YOUNG, Girls</u> (Taitajat Axel ja kaksoishyppyjä) born 1999 or later, Finnish Star-evaluation Free program: max 2.30 min.

1. Max. 5 jump elements.

- At least one (1) and no more than three (3) jump combinations or sequences

2. At least one (1) but not more than three (3) spins (min. 3 revolutions)

3. Step sequence (at least ½ cover of the ice)

4. At least 2 spirals (in spirals at least 2 positions à 3 sec.)

Axel and double jump(s) are allowed, which may be repeated only once in a jump combination/sequence

DEBS A

born 1.7.2000 and younger (ISU evaluation) Free program: time 3 min. (+/- 10 sec) 10 elements

1. Max. 6 jump elements

-1 of which must be Axel jump

-At least 1 and max. 3 jump combinations or jump sequences of which max. 1 jump combination may consist of 3 jumps

-If a double (or triple) jump is executed as a solo jump, it can only be repeated once as part of a jump combination or jump sequence

-The program should include at least 4 different double jumps

2. Max. 3 different spins (every spin has to have different abbreviation!)

-Spin combination (8 revolutions) with or without change of foot

-Flying spin with no change of foot and position at least 5 revolutions

-Camel spin with one change of foot (4+4 revolutions)

3. 1 choreographic sequence must fully utilize the ice surface

Bonus: Each jump named 2A or triple jump, gives the skater a bonus.

2A = +2,0 points, triple jump = +3,0 points. The maximum bonus is + 9,0 points counted from the three most valuable bonus jumps

The program component factor is 1,5.

NOVICE B

born 1.7.1998 or after (ISU evaluation) Free program: time 3 min. (+/- 10 sec) 10 elements

1. Max. 6 jump elements

-1 of which must be Axel jump

-At least 1 and max. 3 jump combinations or jump sequences of which max. 1 jump combination may consist of 3 jumps

-If a double (or triple) jump is executed as a solo jump, it can only be repeated once as part of a jump

combination or jump sequence

-The program should include at least 3 different double jumps

2. Max. 3 different spins (every spin has to have different abbreviation!)

-Spin combination (8 revolutions) with or without change of foot

Novice C, Girls

(Aluenoviisit)

born 1.7.1999 or later (ISU evaluation) Free program: max 3 min. 10 sec 10 elements

1. Max. 6 jump elements

-1 of which must be Axel jump

-At least 1 and max. 3 jump combinations or jump sequences of which max. 1 jump combination may consist of 3 jumps

-If a double (or triple) jump is executed as a solo jump, it can only be repeated once as part of a jump combination or jump sequence

-The program should include at least 3 different double jumps

2. Max. 3 different spins (every spin has to have different abbreviation!)

-Spin combination (8 revolutions) with or without change of foot

-One Spin with one position and no change of foot or flying spin with no change of foot and position (5 revolutions: any position - upright, layback, camel, sit)

-One spin different nature than previous 1 position spin 5 revolutions or spin combination 8 revolutions **3.** 1 choreographic sequence must fully utilize the ice surface

Program component factor is 1.2

The deduction for each fall is -0.5 points/fall.

JUNIOR B, Ladies

born 1.7.1994-30.6.2000 (ISU evaluation) Free program: max 3.40 min 11 elements

1. Max. 7 jump elements.

- One must be Axel type jump.

- At least 1 and max. 3 jump combinations or jump sequences of which max. 1 jump combination may consist of 3 jumps.

- If a double/triple jump is executed as a solo jump, it can only be repeated once as part of a jump combination or jump sequence

2. Max 3 different spins of a different nature.

- One which must be a spin combination (min 10 rev) with or without a change of foot.

- One must be a spin in one foot and in one position (min 5 rev) and may start with a jump.

- One spin different nature than previous 1 position spin 5 revolutions or spin combination 10 revolutions

3. 1 Step sequence must fully utilize the ice surface (StSq)

The free program component factor is 1,6
